

Rainbow Fish Art

Materials:

Paper plate, paint, toilet paper roll, construction paper, brushes, glue, markers, scissors and a surface to paint on.

Instructions:

- 1) Paint the entire surface of the paper plate blue.
- Cut the toilet paper rolls in half lengthwise to create the shape needed for the scales.
- Place other paint colors on separate plates and then place one end of the cut toilet paper roll in the paint.
- 4) When the blue surface is dry, add scales on top of the

blue paper plate by dipping the toilet paper roll in paint and then onto the blue-covered paper plate.

- 5) Once you are finished adding the scales, then cut out the fins for the fish. These can just be big triangles and assist the child as needed.
 6) Finally, glue on the fins and draw an eye on
- Variations:

with a marker.

- Glue some pieces of tinfoil to give your fish some shimmer just like Rainbow Fish!
- Glue on a googly eye instead of drawing on the eye.
